Senior Member Benefits:

- » Leadership Eligibility: Senior members are eligible to hold executive IEEE volunteer positions.

Eligibility:

To be eligible for Senior Membership you must:

- » be an engineer, scientist, educator, technical executive, or originator in IEEE-designated fields
- » have experience reflecting professional maturity
- » have been in professional practice for at least ten years
- » show significant performance over a period of at least five of their years in professional practice

- » You must have one reference from a Senior Member, Fellow or Honorary Member.
